 - Hence, proposal is dismissed.
- Last month Alice posted tear-off flyers inside bathroom stalls in Willow Groave Mall. A few days after the PAIG meeting, Phil received a call from Willow Grove security with a complaint and notice that this can not be done in the future. However, someone showed up at Alice's meeting because of a flyer in bathroom stall.

New Business

Vote on World Service Business Conference Motions

Vote only on motions to be discussed at the upcoming WSBC. Mary created a Summary with highlights to discuss/vote on motions.

If more than 50% say 'yes', it could possibly make it to the Agenda. If more than 50% say 'no', it won't.

1st highlighted one is a policy amendment. Amend definition of abstinence by removing the word "weight". End with "healthy body" instead. Definiton of abstinence was updated back in 2021.

93% voted yes, 7% voted no

2nd highlighted one revolves around the scheduling of the WSBC, to avoid religious holidays to support inclusivity.

93% voted yes, 7% voted no (14 – yes, 1 – no)

3rd highlighted one refers to changing the word "Him" to "God". Some IG's are already changing the word. Violates Tradition, 1, 4, and 10. Would affect multiple pieces of literature. Changes to Steps 3, 4 and 11.

- Trish's meeting discussed in detail. Some people may not like the word "God" so group had mixed feelings.
- Debbie mentioned that this came up before in WSBC and didn't pass. Also a cost to update literature but maybe it's time for an update. Rationale mentioned that this wouldn't take place until re-printing is needed (low inventory)

67% voted yes, 33% voted no

4th highlighted one similar to 3rd one but in the Traditions (Tradition 2). 67% voted yes, 33% voted no

Mary to forward voting results to World Service.

Closing

Shari motioned to close the meeting. Ed seconded. Motion passed.
