- Total operating funds: \$8,069.02
- Shari: we've talked about reducing prudent reserve because we have so few expenses. Phil concurred and said that PAIG could reduce it to \$1,000. He'll do an analysis and present it next month.)
- Motion to approve Treasurer's Report made, seconded and passed.

Secretary (Outgoing) (Shari B.)

- Meeting minutes were sent out on Monday, July 1st. No changed noted.
- Natasha motioned to approve the minutes. Trish seconded. Motion passed.
