Intergroup Inventory

Do we address the specific needs of our members, e.g., young people or the physically challenged, and try to find ways to meet their needs without isolating them?

Discussion about representation of groups that feel under-represented (i.e. physical or mentally challenged, anorexics). Used to have A/B meetings. Also, does that qualify them to be in key service positions? Above meeting level, need to be inclusive especially with members speaking different languages.

Questions/Issues from Groups:

Laura L. brought up issue of young person who attends the Monday morning Warminster meeting. Difficult to relate since average age of the group is late 60s. How do we make it more attractive to young people? Discussion of resources (i.e. young person's meetings online) + personal experiences ensued. Suggested to show up where young people are. Focus on the message.

WSBC Delegate A (Trish M):

In this month's AWARE, a call to action to submit stories for new secular reader. Trish is on the Conference Approved Literature Committee for World Service, sub-committee for a secular daily reader. For people who don't identify with the traditional Judeo-Christian traditions and subscribe to a different spiritual thought process.

The other item committee is working on is a motion to go to WSBC. Motion is to introduce a serenity statement as an option for closing prayers. Instead of "Grant me the serenity...", change to "We seek the serenity..." First, the motion will be sent to service bodies to vote on whether to bring it up for discussion at 2026's WSBC.

Program (Jean M):

Thinking about sending out a survey of workshop topics + would you attend in-person event? Or only on Zoom? Days/time windows. Shari can create a web survey and send out to PAIG's Google group. Would just need the questions.

Suggested topics: Sponsorship, service, tools. Need to be creative about workshops on sponsorship to get people to come. Something like "Paying it Forward" or something with a catchier title. Would need available sponsors. A tricky workshop to put on.

Other suggestions: workshops that address practical applications such as making abstinence portable, attending parties, how to travel, how do you apply Program to your life. How to pick a food plan (i.e. sober eating).

Retreat 2025 (Chris N):

Had wrap-up meeting. Retreat was a success. Next year's retreat is September 25-27, 2026 at Malvern Retreat Center

PI/PO (Alice P & Anthony H):

Putting up flyers.

Put classified ad in Uptight Suburbanite for free for 3 months. Simple text (no graphic). Alice pulling back a little bit.

Anthony also putting up a lot of flyers, sometimes multiple times as sometimes flyers were taken down. Penny Power is a magazine that covers Lehigh Valley area. In stores on racks. Brought Anthony back to OA when someone from FoH meeting placed ad years ago. Wants to place 6" ad (one that Alice texted him) - \$67.50/week. 22,000 people circulation / month.

Anthony made motion to spend a maximum \$350 on placing an ad for 5 weeks. Ed M seconded motion. Motion unanimously carried. To start in January.

May want to look into doing/placing digital ads too. TikTok videos as well. Will help to attract young people.

A little slow this past month. Received 1 request for the list. Announce at meetings that lists are available and if someone wants to be on the list, to contact Laura. There are 2 lists – PAIG and Region 7.

Web (Shari B):
